Soon after their marriage in 1998 the new couple began to plan their life together in vocational ministry.

In 2001 Mark and Tara moved to Guayaquil, Ecuador, where Mark pastored a bilingual church called San Agustín. After two years of serving cross-culturally, the Lord called the Weathers back to the States to minister in Concord, NC.

Mark currently serves as senior pastor at Providence Presbyterian Church where he has been ministering for over ten years. Mark and Tara have three sons: Walker, Liam and Stephen Paul. Mark enjoys teaching, art, cooking with his wife, and hiking in the mountains with his family.
