Death, being the wages of sin, why are not the righteous delivered from death, seeing all their sins are forgiven in Christ?

The righteous shall be delivered from death itself at the return of Christ, and even in death are delivered from the sting and curse of it; so that, although they **die, yet it is out of God’s love, to free them perfectly from sin and misery, and** to make them capable of further communion with Christ in glory, which they then enter upon.
