Q. What do you believe about the Father?

A. We believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

Q. What do you believe about the Son?

A. We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of his Father before all ages, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made; being of one substance with the Father. By whom all things were made. Who for us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man. He was crucified for us under Pontius Pilate; he suffered and was buried. And the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures. He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. And He shall come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom shall have no end.

Q. What do you believe about the Holy Spirit?

A. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets.

Q. What do you believe about the church?

A. We believe in one holy catholic* and apostolic church, we acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins, we look for the resurrection of the dead, and to life of the world to come. Amen.
