How do we know about God?

Although the light of nature, and the works of creation and providence, do so far show the goodness, wisdom, and power of God, as to leave men inexcusable; yet they are not enough to give that knowledge of God, and of his will, which is necessary for salvation: therefore it pleased the Lord, at many times, and in many ways, to reveal himself, and to declare his will unto his Church; and afterwards, for the better preserving and spreading of the truth, and for the more sure establishment and comfort of the Church against the corruption of the flesh, and the malice of Satan and of the world, to commit it to writing; which makes the Holy Scripture to be most necessary; **those former ways of God’s revealing his will unto his people being now ceased.**
