²⁰ Then Job arose and tore his robe and shaved his head and fell on the ground and worshiped. ²¹ **And he said, “Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.”**
